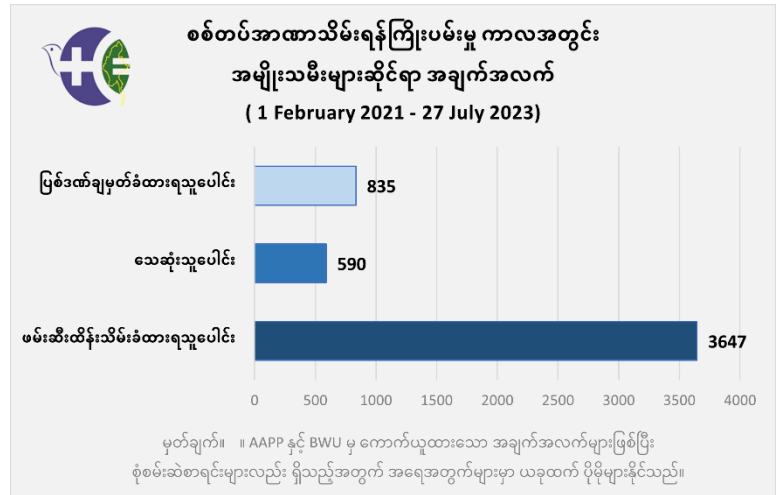




In July 2023, the number of women arrested and detained increased. Meanwhile, the number of women fatalities has also increased rapidly.

Since the day of the attempted coup until July 27th 2023, there are a total of **(3,647)** women who were arbitrarily arrested and detained by the military junta. The **(835)** women who have been arrested and detained are being unjustly convicted. Thus, there were **(22)** women who have been convicted to sentences.



Most of those arrested in July 2023 were unable to confirm the accusations of their arrests. Some women have been arrested for writing posts regarding the military junta's members to change side while others have been arrested for alleged ties to revolutionary forces. Furthermore, there have been some arbitrary arrests of women for allegedly being linked to the bombs that exploded near the offices of the military junta.



From 1st to 27th July 2023, **(19)** women were arrested by the military junta. Those detainees were from Yangon, Mandalay, Magway, Bago, Sagaing and Tanitari region, Shan and Mon states. Bago region had the highest number of women arrested up to **(5)**, and Sagaing and Tanitari region had the second highest women detainees with **(3)**.

In addition, **(590)** women have lost their lives during the attempted military coup. From 2023 July 1st to 27th, women fatality rate is up to **(21)** deaths. Among those

deceased women, **(11)** women were found dead because of the artillery. **(6)** women were shot to death by military junta forces while **(3)** women were dead due to the airstrike and **(1)** woman was burned to death alive by military junta forces while raiding the villages and torched.

This report is compiled by the Burmese Women's Union mainly based on the information provided by the Assistance Association for Political Prisoners (AAPP) and as well as information published by reliable media agencies. Due to the challenges of restriction on the information flows and communication cut off, the number on the ground could be much higher than the number which shown in this report.
