

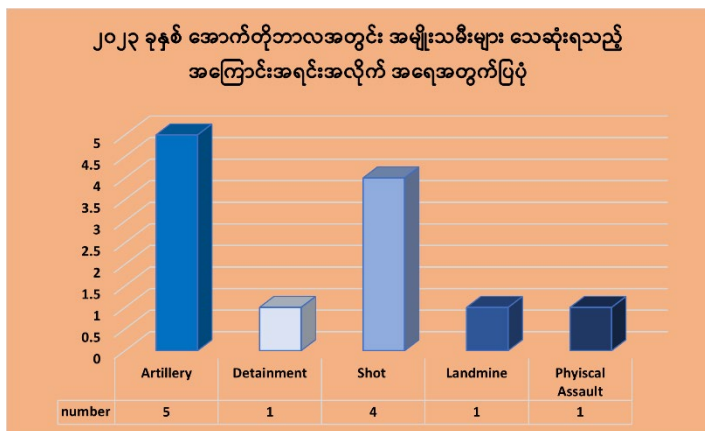


October 2023

Throughout October 2023, as the military junta arrests and sentences women, the number of women killed by their heavy weapons is on the increase. From the day of the attempted coup 1st February 2021 to October 26th, 2023, there are total of **(3,232)** women were arbitrarily arrested and detained by the military junta. The **(668)** women who have been arrested and detained are being unjustly convicted. Thus, there were **(10)** women who have been convicted to sentences.



The majority of women detained were subjected to arbitrary detention. Among them, some faced arrests under the accusation of composing and disseminating false information on social media platforms like Facebook. Others were arrested and detained with the accusation of providing financial support to NUG and PDFs.



by military junta forces while **one** woman was dead due **one** woman deceased during the detainment, and another **woman** lost her life due to strangulation at the hands of the military junta forces.

This fact sheet is compiled by the Burmese Women's Union mainly based on the information provided by the Assistance Association for Political Prisoners (AAPP) and information published by reliable media agencies. Due to the challenges of restriction on the free flow of information and disruptions in communication, the actual number on the ground could be much higher than the number presented in this report.

From 1st October to 26th October 2023, **(10)** women were arrested by military junta. Those detainees were from Yangon, Magway, Bago, Sagaing, Mandalay region and Mon state.

In addition, **(628)** women have lost their lives during the attempted military coup. From 2023 October 1st to 26^h, women's fatality rate is up to **(12)** deaths. Among those women fatalities, **five** women were found dead by the artillery shelling of the military junta. **Four** women were shot to death to the landmine of the military junta. Additionally,
