Women's Information Sactsheet July 2024

It has been more than three years since the military terrorists attempted the coup on 1st February 2021; the people of Myanmar are still strongly against the dictatorial system with various forms of resistance like non-violent ways as well as armed revolution. Women are being killed every day due to grave human rights violations committed by military terrorists. Thus, the presented data are monitored and collected on reliable media by the Burmese Women's Union (BWU). The actual figures could be higher on the ground due to the challenges and limitations of free-flow information, as BWU faces numerous obstacles and challenges in accessing data and information.

Due to BWU's data monitoring from various reliable media, (63) women were killed from 1st -31st July 2024, across the country. Among them (33) women lost their lives due to military artillery shelling targeting civilian homes and villages, (10) were killed by the military without reason, women died in the military airstrike (9), (4) women died due to crossfire in the fighting, (4) women died due to the military drone attacked, (2) women lost lives due to fire by the military, (1) woman was raped and killed by the military. In addition, (43) were wounded; among them, (26) were by military artillery shelling, (11) were due to aerial bombardment by the military, (3) were due to rape by the military and civilians and (3) women were because of the drone by the military.



Number of women Fatality by Regions and States

Following the media data collected by BWU, the number of women fatalities was (22) from Shan State, (17) from Mandalay Region, and (10) from Sagaing Region respectively; Shan State had the highest number of women deaths in July 2024.

Number of Women Detainees by Regions

Based on the BWU's data monitoring, (2) women were arrested across the country during this July. However, the number of women arrested could be higher on the ground. According to Assistance Association for Political Prisoners (AAPP) data, (5, 611) women have been arrested and (4,066) women are still under detained since the military attempted coup on 31st July 2024.
