## Women's Information Factsheet August 2024

It has been more than three years since the military terrorist attempted the coup on 1st February 2021; the people of Myanmar are still strongly against the dictatorial system with various forms of resistance like non-violent ways as well as armed revolution. Women are being killed every day due to grave human rights violations committed by the military terrorist. Thus, the presented data are monitored and collected on reliable media by the Burmese Women's Union (BWU). The actual figures could be higher on the ground due to the challenges and limitations of free-flow information, as BWU faces numerous obstacles and challenges in accessing data and information.

Based on BWU data monitoring from various reliable media, (70) women were killed from 1st -31st August 2024, across the country. Among them (30) women lost their lives due to the military artillery shelling by targeting civilian homes and villages, (4) women were killed by the military without reason, (26) women were killed by the military airstrikes (26), (6) women were killed by shot,(2) women died due to crossfire in the fighting, (2) women died because of landmine. In addition, (59) were wounded; among them, (27) were by the military artillery shelling, (15) were due to aerial bombardment by the military, (1) was raped by the military, (2) were by shot, (11) were due to landmine, (1) was physically torture by the Prison Staff under the military and (2) women were because of the bombing.





Number of women Fatality by Regions and States

Following the media data collected by BWU, the number of women fatalities was (14) from Sagaing Region, (10) from Magway Region, and (9) from Mandalay Region respectively; Sagaing Region had the highest number of women deaths in August 2024.

## **Number of Women Detainees by Regions**



Based on the BWU's data monitoring, (7) women were arrested across the country during this August. However, the number of women arrested could be higher on the ground. According to Assistance Association for Political Prisoners (AAPP) data, (5,649) women have been arrested and (4,029) women are still under detained since the military attempted coup on 31st August 2024.
