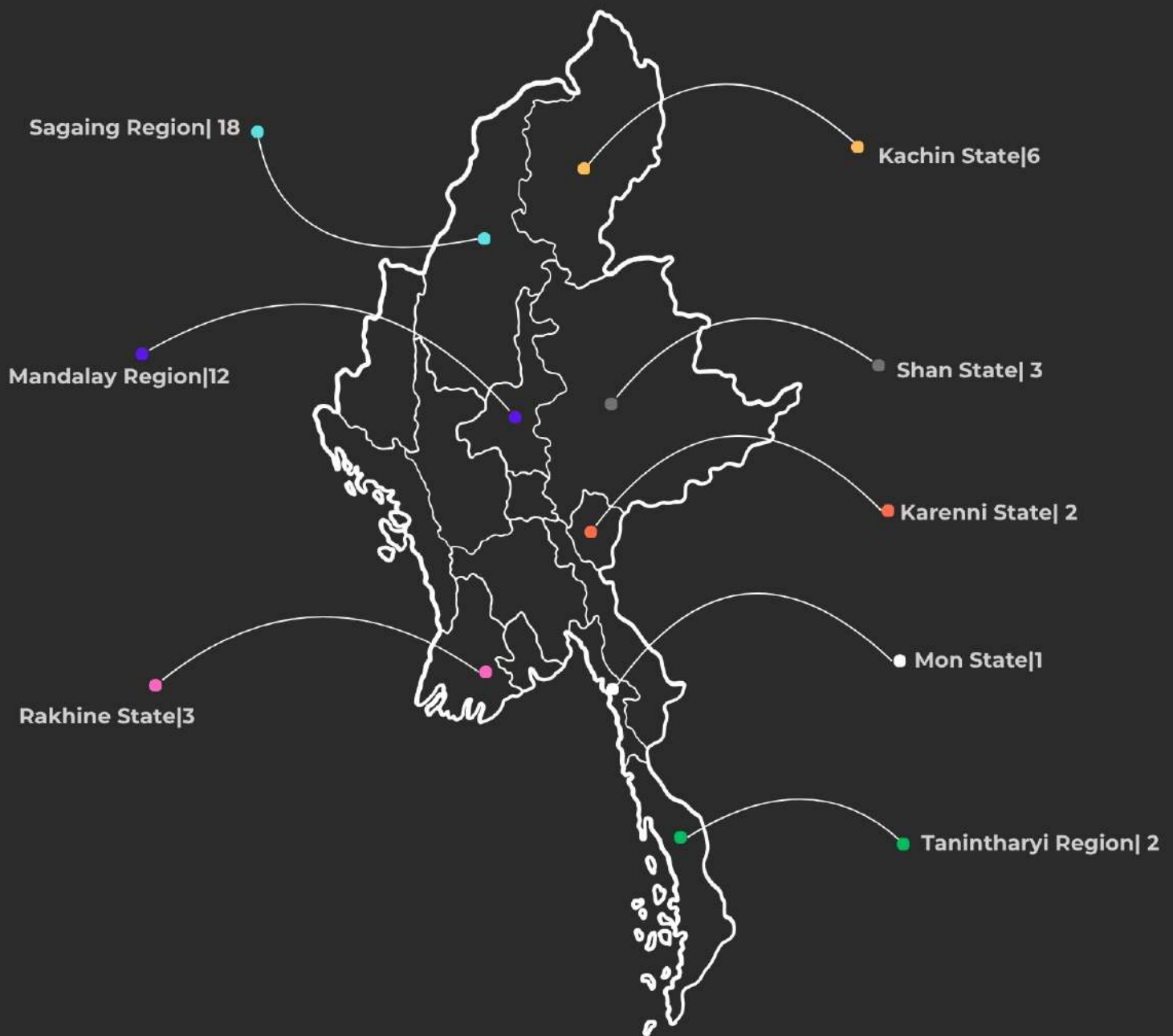
Almost five years have passed since the illegal military junta attempted the coup on February 1, 2021. Throughout these years, the illegal military junta have continued to commit various forms of severe human rights violations that amount to war crimes and crimes against humanity. For women, due to the various forms of human rights violations that they face on a daily basis, including conflict-related sexual violence, many have lost their lives. In September 2025 alone, 47 women have been killed. The reported data has been monitored and collected from reliable media sources by Burmese Women's Union (BWU). However, BWU encounters numerous obstacles when accessing data and information; therefore, the actual figures may be much higher on the ground.

Numbers of Women were Killed and Injured

Based on BWU data monitoring from various reliable media sources, (47) women were killed across the country in September 2025. Among them, (36) women were killed by the military airstrikes, (5) women lost their lives due to the military artillery shelling that targeted civilian homes and villages, and (4) women died due to extrajudicial killing, (1) was killed by crossfire, and (1) woman was killed due to conflict-related sexual violence. Among them (47) women who have been killed, (3) were under the age 18, including a pregnant woman. In addition, (57) women were wounded, (32) women were wounded due to aerial bombardment by the military, (9) women were injured by the military artillery shelling and (1) woman was injured by landmine and (15) women were physical injured due to conflict-related sexual violence.

Number of Women Killed By State and Region



Based on the data that was monitored and collected by BWU, the number of women fatalities in September 2025 was (18) from Sagaing Region, (12) from Mandalay Region, and (6) from Kachin State . Therefore, Sagaing Region recorded the highest number of women killed in September 2025.
